Robert Smith of Remington, Vernick & Walberg provided the contracts for the furnishing and delivery of Wood Chips for execution and return. Those contracts have since been executed and one fully executed contract document has been returned to Warriner's Construction for their records.

Mr. Smith also informed the board that three sets of contract documents were sent to Xylem Dewatering Solutions, Inc. for the furnishing and delivery of a trailer mounted pump. Once they execute and return the contracts Mr. Smith will forward them to the office for execution by Chairman Santagata.

An email was received from the Borough of Buena Solicitor, Rick Tonetta by Robert Smith of Remington, Vernick & Walberg regarding the experience requirement in the electrical repair and maintenance bid document. Mr. Smith forwarded the scope of work to Mr. Tonetta which states that the 15 year requirement is in performing electrical repair and maintenance services in the areas that include but are not limited to wastewater treatment plants, sanitary sewer pump stations and potable production wells not 15 years in business as a company.

The original resolution authorized 100 hours of work at a rate of \$50.00 per hour. However, due to the extensive changes in the 2015 annual budget format and information required by the State of NJ combined with computer related issues that were encountered the approved hours have been utilized. Therefore, Ms. Chalow is requesting an additional 40 hours totaling \$2,000.00 be approved to complete the 2014 Audit papers and any necessary entries.
