The cost will include bid phase support services, processing of contract documents, contract administration and part-time construction observation, review pump repair recommendations provided by contractor and observe removed well pump and motor components being refurbished at the contractor's site as well as observing a final video inspection and pump tests once the well is placed back into service. These services will be provided at a cost not to exceed \$12,500.00. The preliminary budget for the total project is estimated to be \$85,000.00.
