Robert Smith of Remington, Vernick & Walberg informed the board that he sent the contract documents for execution and return to Univar USA, Inc. for the furnishing and delivery of Liquid Aluminum Sulfate.

Mr. Smith also informed the board the contract documents for the furnishing and delivery of Wood Chips were mailed for Warriner's Construction for execution and return. The high bidder's bid bond was returned to Jersey Mulch Products, LLC as well.

Robert Smith made a recommendation to award the contract for the Furnishing and Delivery of Water Meters to Rio Supply, Inc. in the amount of \$44,100.00.

Kim Curtin of Solis partners submitted the application for the NJBPU renewable energy grant without our letter of support or signature on the application. I told him that we would not be making any commitment in anyway prior to a public bid to comply with the NJ Public Contracts Law.

Secretary/Treasurer Cheryl Santore received an email from the BBMUA Solicitor, Michael Testa Jr. of Testa, Heck, Scrocca & Testa providing a legal opinion on the bid for the trailer mounted pump. Due to the fact that the bid bond was not signed being a fatal material defect the bid must be rejected and rebid. Therefore, a resolution must be adopted rejecting the bid and authorizing re-advertisement.
